

HRVATSKA VIŠE NIJE DIO MREŽE TRANSPARENCY INTERNATIONAL

ZAGREB » Transparency International Hrvatske (TIH) više se ne nalazi na popisu ogranaka i kontakata međunarodnog Transparency Internationala (TI), tako da je sad domaća verzija najpoznatije svjetske antikorupcijske institucije i faktički prestala imati s njima suradnju. Jučer se nije moglo doći do službenog objašnjenja zašto je došlo do brisanja TIH-a iz registra, jer u centrali TI u Berlinu nije bilo osobe zadužene za kontakte s medijima, obzirom da je vikend. Neslužbeno se tek doznaje kako se radi o konačnoj kulminaciji problema koje TIH ima od 2014. godine, kad je došlo do izbacivanja dijela članova iz organizacije nakon što je Davorka Blažević preuzela predsjedavanje. Ministarstvo uprave čak je bilo i odbilo upis nje kao predsjednice u Registar neprofitnih udruga, zbog proceduralnih grešaka. Ona je ipak nastavila voditi TIH, no berlinska centrala je zamjetila probleme te je TIH jedno vrijeme bio pod suspenzijom, dok se ne riješi ova problematika. Kako je ovaj tjedan maknuta oznaka »pod suspenzijom« sa stranica TI i prebrisan čitav TIH, za pretpostaviti je kako u Berlinu nisu bili zadovoljni rješavanjem ove situacije, ali i općenitim radom TIH-a. Time smo postali jedina država u čitavoj Srednjoj i južnoj Europi koja je bez svoje službene lokalne podružnice ove organizacije. (D. Ra.)

TIC erased from the anti-corruption organisation

Croatia is no longer a part of the Transparency International Network

ZAGREB. Transparency International Croatia (TIH) is no longer on the list of branches and contacts of the international Transparency International (TI) organization. This means that a domestic version of the world's most famous anti-corruption institution in fact seized its cooperation with them. It was not possible to provide an official opinion as to why it has come to the point of wiping out TIH from the TI's registrar since there was no person in Berlin available yesterday in charge for media contacts, considering the pending weekend. Unofficially, though, we discovered that this was an epilogue of the problem that has been dragging on since 2014 when several members were terminated from the organization at which point Mrs. Davorka Blažević took over the presidency over this TI branch. Ministry of Administration eventually refused to enter her presidency in the official administration registrar of the non-profit organization due to procedural errors. In spite of that, she continued to run the branch, however, the Berlin HQ noticed these problems and suspended temporarily TIH from its network until the resolution of this administrative issue. This „suspension“ was finally lifted this week, but simultaneously, TIH was also erased from the TI network entirely. It is suspected that the Berlin HQ was not satisfied with the overall resolution of this situation as well as with the very work of the TIH branch. This way, Croatia became the only country in the middle and southern Europe without a local branch of this organization (D.Ra.)
